## UNIFORM REGULATIONS

The wearing of uniform in this school has always been of a high standard. Therefore **UNIFORM MUST BE WORN PROPERLY in school and on the way to and from school**. We refer you to the uniform list issued and request your ongoing and consistent support in ensuring that this is adhered to. There are a number of uniform and general appearance issues we wish to highlight.

1.	Blazers are <b>compulsory</b> for all pupils.
2.	A badged school pullover is compulsory. (This may be with or without sleeves.)
3.	From September 2011, parents buying new ties should purchase the new, clip-on school tie. All ties should be worn with the top button of the shirt done up.
4.	The formal white shirt must be tucked neatly into trousers or skirts, although the informal shirt may be worn outside trousers/skirts. Garments worn under the informal shirt should <b>NOT</b> be visible at the neck or sleeves.
5.	Plain black leather shoes with flattish heels, appropriate for wear in school, must be worn.
6.	Girls' black knee length kick pleat skirts must be worn with black knee length socks or black tights. Girls have the option of wearing black trousers from Hallowe'en to Easter, but at <b>NO</b> other time. <b>N.B. THESE MUST BE THE SKIRTS &amp; TROUSERS STOCKED BY OUR SUPPLIERS.</b>
7.	Outdoor coats must be black and should not be worn on school premises. Coloured 'hoodies' or tracksuit tops are <b>NOT</b> permitted.
8.	Only the school scarf or a black scarf may be worn with the uniform, but only to and from school and not around the campus.
9.	Boys' and girls' hair should be clean, neat, tidy and not excessively dyed, streaked or shaven and should have no motifs. Hair should not be of an <b>unnatural colour</b> , for example pink, purple, green, blue, crimson, platinum or any other shade of synthetic appearance. Hair should not conceal eyes or face and facial hair is <b>NOT</b> permitted. Hair accessories should be black and appropriate for school. Boys' hair should not exceed collar length.
10	Only basic jewellery should be worn -e.g. A watch and ring. Girls may wear one stud earring in each ear lobe and nowhere else. Boys <b>must not</b> wear any ear jewellery. <b>Nose studs, eyebrow rings or tongue studs WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.</b> Neck jewellery should not be visible.
11	Girls are permitted to wear light makeup in Years 10, 11, 12, lower and upper 6 <sup>th</sup> , but no makeup should be worn by pupils in Years 8 and 9
12	All personal property and clothing should be clearly marked with the pupil's name.
13	Only school related (eg. Duke of Edinburgh Award, Youth Award, designated charity of the month, etc.) badges may be worn on school uniform.
14	Uniform for Sports and P.E. as by uniform list.

**NOTE:** Limavady High School strongly advises that mobile phones, MP3 players and all other personal music devices, etc should not be brought into school. If any part of the device is visible, or is used, the complete device will be confiscated. The device will then be stored safely in the School Office and the pupil's parent or guardian should come into school to collect this on the same day, **but no earlier than 3.30pm**. If a parent or guardian is unable to collect the device, the pupil may collect it after 3.30pm on the **following** day. The sanction for breaking this school rule will **normally** be one After-School Detention.
